Clinical Haematology

We are pleased to welcome you to the Ambulatory Day Ward at the Royal Liverpool University Hospital.

This leaflet has been designed to provide you with important information about your visit, what to expect and how to prepare for your treatment.

Please take a few minutes to read through this information.

What is Clinical Haematology?

Clinical Haematology is the area of medicine that deals with blood and blood-related conditions.

We provide specialist services across Cheshire, Merseyside and the wider Northwest.

Clinical Services include:

- General /Consultative Haematology
- Thrombosis Services
- Anticoagulation Services
- Bleeding Disorders Services (including Haemophilia Comprehensive Care Centre)
- Immunohematology Services (including Immune Thrombocytopenia and Auto Immune Haemolytic Anaemia)
- Thrombotic Thrombocytopenic Purpura, (TTP) and other Thrombotic Microangiopathies.
- Red Cell Disorders (including Specialist Haemoglobinopathy Team for patients with Sickle Cell and Thalassemia
- Obstetric Haematology Services (jointly with Liverpool Women's Hospital)
- Haematology Psychology Service
- Haematology Research Service

On the Day of your Appointment

Arrival Time:

Arrive at the Day Ward on time to allow for registration and preparation. If you are running late, please call the Day Ward on 0151 706 3397 to inform us. The Day Ward is situated within the main hospital. The lift is on the ground floor opposite outpatient's 1. If you take the lift to the 1st floor, then follow the signs for Haematology Ambulatory Day Ward.

Treatment Duration

The length of your visit will depend on the type of treatment or procedure you are having. It can vary from a few hours to a full day.

If you are receiving an Infusion, blood transfusion, or similar treatments, please expect to stay for the duration of the procedure plus recovery time.

Discharge:

You will be discharged once the medical/ nursing team is confident that you are stable and well enough to leave. You will receive aftercare instructions and information on any further appointments.

Aftercare and Recovery

After your treatment, it's important to follow instructions by your healthcare team. These may include.

Rest:

Take it easy for the rest of the day and avoid strenuous activities.

You may feel tired or experience mild discomfort, but this should improve over time.

Medications:

Follow any instructions regarding prescribed medication, including pain relief or antibiotics, if applicable

Important Information to Remember

You will be given a date and time to attend for your appointment. If you require an unscheduled visit this must be agreed and organised by the day ward staff in advance. We do not accept walk ins.

Emergency Contact:

If you have any questions or concerns before or after your visit, please contact the Day Ward at 0151 706 3397.

Our opening times are Monday to Friday 9:00 to 17:00. Please note we are not open at weekends.

In case of any issues after you return home or if you experience any unusual symptoms, contact the Day Ward within our opening times of 9-5 Monday to Friday or if out of these hours please seek alternative medical advice.

Following your discharge from hospital or attendance at your outpatient appointment you will receive a text asking if you would recommend our service to others.
