Your diagnosis and treatment

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Today you have agreed for us to make the following community referrals:

Community Holistic needs assessment - The Community Cancer Navigators provide holistic support for people living with and beyond cancer. The support from the Navigators also extends to carers, family members or anyone living with or affected by cancer. Navigators are skilled in helping the patient to identify concerns or needs. The Navigators provide a range of signposting and support with onward referrals as well as providing support across 4 key areas:

Physical, Practical , Emotional & Financial.

District Nurse - District nurses provide essential care and support to patients in their homes, offering services such as medicine management and symptom control, while also providing advice and support for family members and carers. They act as a link between hospital and home.

- Benefits and financial support
- Support for different types of cancer
- Information on symptoms and treatments
- Tips of reducing risk of cancer
- Therapies
- Support in talking to children.
