If you need emergency care please show this leaflet to whoever treats you.

You have received sedation to help you accept dental treatment. This was given to help you relax but often makes you feel drowsy. You must follow these instructions, even if you do not feel drowsy.

Until tomorrow morning:

You should:

- Travel home with your escort. We advise car or taxi, public transport is not ideal.
- Have a responsible adult to stay with you and look after you.
- Have somebody else to care for any children, elderly or sick relatives you usually look after.
- Take your regular prescribed medication as usual.
- Follow any other post-operative instructions given to you by the dentist.
- Relax for the rest of the day; do not do any strenuous exercise.
- Be wary of using the internet/ social media (your judgement may be impaired).

You should not:

- Drive or ride a motorcycle/ bike.
- Operate machinery including domestic appliances such as irons, kettles etc.
- Return to work.
- Travel alone.
- Make important decisions or sign business or legal documents.
- Climb ladders.
- Take any other non-prescribed drugs or alcohol.
