Privacy notice – Information for Children

What is a 'Privacy Notice'?

A 'privacy notice' is a statement issued by an organisation which explains how personal and confidential information about patients, service users, staff and visitors is collected, used and shared.

This privacy notice is issued by Liverpool University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust as a healthcare provider and covers the information we hold about our patients.

Why have we issued this privacy notice?

The NHS (National Health Service) keeps information about you and your health, this information is called a Health Record. This leaflet explains how the trust collects this information and how we keep this information safe. By issuing this privacy notice, we demonstrate our commitment to openness and accountability. We recognise the importance of protecting personal and confidential information in all that we do and take care to meet our legal and other duties.

Who are we and what do we do?

The Trust is a major NHS Trust providing healthcare services across Merseyside and beyond. It was created through the merger of Aintree University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust and Royal Liverpool and Broadgreen University Hospitals NHS Trust.



How does your information help us?

We collect personal and confidential information about you to support with the delivery of appropriate healthcare and treatment. It helps us:

- To give you better care.
- To find ways of giving better health care to everyone.
- To teach doctors, nurses and other health staff.
- To research whether the right care is given to patients.

How do we collect your information?

Your information could be collected in a number of different ways. This might be from a referral made by your GP or perhaps directly from you.

There may also be times when information is collected from your family – for example, if you are taken to our emergency department (A&E) but you are unconscious or unable to communicate.

Lawful basis for processing data

What information do we collect?

Your information can be kept on both paper and electronically. We collect information about you such as:

- Your name.
- Your birthday and the year you were born.
- The name of the person who looks after you and will bring you to your appointments.
- Your Family Doctor (General Practitioner or GP).
- The reason that you are coming to see us.
- Information your family or GP gives us.
- What we do to care for you.

Who else might see your information?

People in other organisations who are also giving you care may need to see your health records.

- · We will have to share your information if:
- You have hurt someone.
- Someone has hurt you.
- You have hurt yourself.

Can I see my health records?

Yes, you can see your health records or ask for a copy. Someone else can get this information for you if you say it is okay.

Can I have a copy of my records?

What if I think my health records are wrong?

If we agree that your health records are wrong, we will make them right and give you a copy. You can also ask us to add important information.

If we do not agree with you, we will make a note on your records that we have talked about this.

Feedback
