Transitioning Alder Hey to Royal Liverpool Hospital

Diabetes and Endocrinology

What is Transition?

In health care, we use the term 'transition' to describe the process of planning, preparing and moving from children's health care to adult health care. Transition is a gradual process of change, giving everyone time to ensure that young people like yourself are prepared and feel ready to make the move to the adult health care setting.

Transition is an important journey, and it is essential that we work in partnership with you and your family/carers to ensure you are fully supported, understand what is happening and feel in control.

When should transition happen?

Many young people move to adult health care between the ages of 16 to 18 years of age.

At Liverpool University Hospital Foundation Trust (LUHFT), we want to make the transition as easy as possible for you. Dr Deepa Beeharry will be your adult Consultant Endocrinologist here at the RLUH.

You will have an allocated member of staff named 'Kerrie Grounds' who is responsible for organising your transition to the adult endocrine team. They will also be responsible for ensuring that you are supported throughout the process and receive all the relevant information needed for you to feel ready to move to adult services.

Kerrie Grounds is an Advanced Clinical Practitioner in Endocrinology at RLUH and takes the 'transition co-coordinator' role in this process.

You can discuss any queries or concerns with any member of your health care team here at RLUH.

Preparing for transition

We know that approaching a move to adult care can be a scary time in a young person's life. As you are getting older, you will start to take more responsibility for your health, medicines and treatment.

Our aim here at the RLUH is to provide support, offer guidance and deliver education to enable you to have all the skills to start taking this responsibility, and to feel comfortable in the adult health care service.

Why do I need to move clinic?

Adults have different endocrinology (hormonal) needs to children. The doctors in the adult clinic are experts in treating adults and making sure your hormones are at the right levels to ensure you stay healthy.

How the Transition Clinic Works

We currently hold a joint transitional endocrine clinic with; Dr Julie Park (Consultant Paediatric Endocrinologist), Dr Deepa Beeharry (Consultant Adult Endocrinologist) and Kerrie Grounds. (Advanced Clinical Practitioner).

Initially the clinic will be held at Alder Hey hospital. However, when you and the members of the Transitional team agree the time is right for you, your care will be transferred to the Transition clinic here at RLUH.

Dr Park will continue to remain present during your attendance here at the RLUH, and the clinics will be held in **Outpatient 2** department located on the ground floor. The aim of the clinic is to make the transition to adult care a successful and positive experience for you.

LUHFT has a fully equipped endocrine investigations unit which is located on Ward 10 at Broadgreen Hospital. This is where you will attend if you need any 'in depth' tests, of your hormone levels.

We have a team of Endocrine Specialist Nurses who provide both outpatient and inpatient services. We are here as a point of contact, and support network for you. We have a telephone helpline and telephone follow up service.


