Welcome to the Liverpool Falls Assessment Clinic in the Department of Medicine for Older People and Stroke

Department of Medicine for Older People and Stroke

The Liverpool Falls Assessment Service is for patients who have fallen and attended the Emergency Department (A&E) at the Royal Liverpool Hospital, or have been referred by their family doctor (GP).

The aim of the service is to identify factors that may have caused the fall and find ways of reducing the risk of further falls.

Location

We are situated on the lower ground floor of the Alexandra Wing of Broadgreen Hospital.

When you arrive

When you arrive at the department you should book into reception. You will be seen in the nurse-led clinic and during your assessment you will meet various members of the multidisciplinary falls team. A member of the nursing team will begin your assessment and explain your visit.

As Broadgreen Hospital is a teaching hospital there may be students at your consultation. If you have any objections to their presence please speak to the nurse in charge.

The Liverpool Falls Assessment Team

Nurses

The nursing staff are available throughout your visit to offer you help, advice, and support. A nurse will complete your health assessment, including checking your weight, height, lying and standing (postural) blood pressure and take a brief history of your falls/collapses.

Physiotherapist

The physiotherapist will assess your muscle strength, gait, and balance and plan your treatment with you. This may include exercises to help you in your day to day activities and referrals for follow up physiotherapy if necessary. They may also assess whether a walking aid will benefit you.

Occupational Therapist

The occupational therapist will talk to you about how you are managing at home. They assess you in the department or arrange a home visit to determine if you need any equipment/adaptations in your home to reduce your falls risk. They will also discuss the installation of a falls alarm, which can assist in the event of a fall in the home

Pharmacist Medication Review

If you are on more than four medications or if there are any concerns over medications a pharmacist will review your regime either in clinic if available, or as soon as possible after clinic using your Summary Care Record (SCR) data with your permission.

Communication

Following your assessment a letter will be sent to yourself and your family doctor detailing the results of the assessment and all recommendations

Please note Broadgreen Hospital operates a 'No Smoking Policy'.

No one is allowed to smoke in any of the Trust buildings or within Trust grounds.

Important Information

Before and during your appointment your NHS Summary Care Record (SCR) will be available to view by certain hospital staff involved in your care, unless you have previously opted out of having SCR. Your SCR contains important information from your GP record including current medications, allergies and any bad reactions to medicines.

If you do not want our staff to access your SCR please inform staff at the start of your assessment.

Feedback

Your feedback is important to us and helps us influence care in the future.

Following your discharge from hospital or attendance at your outpatient appointment you will receive a text asking if you would recommend our service to others. Please take the time to text back, you will not be charged for the text and can opt out at any point. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.
