Your Child has had a General Anaesthetic for a Surgical Procedure

What to do when your child goes home

- Most children appear quite alert and active when they are discharged from hospital. However, your child may complain of feeling dizzy or tired. This is to be expected, you should encourage your child to rest.
- Sometimes children are less steady than usual. This lack of co-ordination can last for about 24 hours; therefore you should ensure that a responsible adult supervises your child's activities.
- Your child should not ride a bike or undertake outdoor activities for 24 hours.
- Your child may complain of a sore throat, hoarseness or muscle aches following an anaesthetic or pain at the site of the operation. If so you can give your child Calpol/Disprol or paracetamol.

Do not exceed the dosage recommended for your child's age.

- Your child may eat or drink normally but it is best to avoid hard-to-digest foods such as chips, burgers etc. until the following day.

What to do if problems happen

- If your child vomits on the way home or at home do not be worried. Give them nothing to eat or drink for one hour then start giving drinks (water or juice), a small amount at first, then increase the amount gradually. If vomiting continues please contact our Emergency Department (A&E) for advice.
