How to Use Eye Drops and Ointment

How to Use Eye Drops and Ointment

Use the drops/ointment as instructed by the doctor. Read the label carefully.

1. Wash your hands thoroughly before and after use.



2. Gently pull down the lower eyelid.





- 3. Hold bottle/tube over the eye and look up.
- 4. Squeeze a drop or half inch of ointment in the space inside the lower lid.

- 5. Try not to touch your eye or lashes with the nozzle of the bottle or tube.
- 6. Let go of the eyelid, close your eye for a few minutes and blink a few times.
- 7. Close your eye and gently wipe any excess with a clean tissue.

If you are using more than one type of drop leave a few minutes between each medication. Always replace the cap immediately.

What side-effects to expect?

- Some drops will affect the size of your pupil.
- The eye drops may sting for a few minutes.
- Your vision may be blurred for a short time afterwards. If your vision is blurred you should not drive or operate machinery.

If you are unable to put in your own eye drops/ointment please inform the doctor.

Nursing staff are available to teach you how to put your drops in.
