Liver Biopsy Aftercare

Gastroenterology and Hepatology

You have had a liver biopsy performed today. This is a routine procedure, which is done as a day case. Rarely problems occur, and monitoring your blood pressure pulse and wound site, will give the nursing staff any sign of any problems. Bleeding can sometimes happen, as can a leak of bile from the liver or gallbladder.

Very rarely these complications may cause you to need surgery.

The biopsy site may feel uncomfortable for a day or two after the biopsy.

You may wish to take painkillers for this in normal doses of up to two paracetamol tablets every six hours. You will need a responsible person to stay with you for 24 hours after the procedure to watch for any of the unusual symptoms listed below.

We advise you to not undertake any heavy lifting or strenuous exercise for at least 48 hours. This is to allow your liver to heal. Please make sure that the dressing over your biopsy site remains in place for 24 hours, to prevent any infection. After the 24 hours you can bathe as normal, and change your dressing with the spare dressing provided.

If you experience any of the symptoms below:

- 1. Feeling faint or dizzy, especially on standing.
- 2. Severe pain around the site of the biopsy or elsewhere in the chest or abdomen.
- 3. Any unusual symptoms.
